

## Liturgy Report

The Liturgy Committee has not met since the last meeting. However, there are some areas to report/reflect upon:

- Children's Christmas Liturgy. This year we instigated an overflow policy to avoid the extreme crush of the past. St. Joseph's Hall was equipped with a video link so that those who were unable to fit into the Church were accommodated downstairs. People were very understanding and it seems to have been a success. It may be something we can do for the *Easter Sunday* 11.30am Mass which is the other very crowded service. The Liturgy itself was very well prepared and rehearsed by the Little Church catechists.

## Catechesis Report

### RCIA

- 16 candidates (between ourselves and St. Mark's) were welcomed on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> Jan. They are a mix of catechumens and candidates. 2 parishioners are also members of the group - they are refreshing their knowledge of the faith.

### Confirmation

- A joint course with St. Mark's started in November with over 40 young people attending. Some of these have dropped out but there is a steady core of 30-34 coming. A team of volunteers (all Mums – we could do with some men!) is assisting Simon and Jane to run the programme.
